

The Fall Feasts of the LORD

A Review of the Spring Feasts

Passover, Pesach (on Nisan 14)

Exodus 12

Historic Significance: Remembering Israel's release from Egypt
The Plagues The Passover Lamb Blood on the Doorpost

Prophetic Significance: Yeshua satisfied the requirements of the Lamb
He Shed His Blood and died on Passover - Nisan 14

Feast of Unleavened Bread *Chag HaMotzi* (7 days starting on Nisan 15)

Leviticus 23: 6-8

Historic Significance: Remembering the unleavened bread eaten leaving Egypt
Prophetic Significance: The Sinless Sacrifice is buried in the ground – Nisan 15

Feast of Firstfruits *Yom HaBikkurim* (on day after Shabbat)

Leviticus 23: 9-14

Historic Significance: Remembering the Red Sea crossing (3 day journey)
Prophetic Significance: Yeshua's resurrection on Firstfruits (3 days in the grave)

Feast of Weeks *Shavuot* (50 days from Firstfruits)

Leviticus 23: 15-22

Historic Significance: Giving of Torah at Mt Sinai (50 days from Red Sea)
Prophetic Significance: Giving of Holy Spirit (Acts 2; 50 days from Resurrection)

Yeshua's Death, Burial, & Resurrection Aligned Perfectly with the Spring Feasts
A Personal Call to Us!

The Fall Feasts

Feast of Trumpets, *Yom Teruah* (on Tishri 1) A Feast of the LORD

Leviticus 23: 23-25

We are to hear the sound of the shofar; Do no work; Holy Convocation

Rosh HaShanah – Same day but completely different events. A Feast of the Jews!

Book of Life is Opened on *Yom Teruah* ... and **Closed 10 days Later** on *Yom Kippur*

	Western Light Went Out	Doors Opened by Themselves

Spiritual Understanding of the Day of Atonement

Sins were only <u>covered</u> – not removed	I Sam 2:24-25
Like a credit card! waiting for the payment “at the end of the month”	
Yeshua takes away our sins!	John 1:29
Grace was poured out on <i>Yom Kippur</i> !	Gal 3:13
..... just as much (if not more) than it is today!	Heb 10:4-6 & 10-12

What Happened on the First Day of Atonement?

Moses returned with Book of the Law on <i>Tishri</i> 10	Exodus 34:29-30
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***Yom Kippur* in Revelation:**

Censer of Burning Coals	Leviticus 16:12-15	Rev 6:9-10 & 8:3-6
Blood-Stained Garments	Priests covered in blood	Rev 19:13-15 & Isa 63:1-4
Entering the Holy of Holies	Only on <i>Yom Kippur</i>	Rev 11:15-19
Atonement for the Holy Place	Leviticus 16:16-17	Rev 15:8

The Feast of Tabernacles, *Sukkot* (7 days starting Tishri 15)

Lev 23: 34-43

Feast of Booths (“The Feast”) Dwell in booths for 7 days (*Tishri* 15-21)

The Festival of Ingathering – Harvest of Olives, Nuts Grapes & other Fruit	Exodus 23:16
The final <i>Shalosh Reg'lim</i>	
When all Jewish men journeyed to Jerusalem	Deut 16:16-17

The Season of Our Joy - Commanded to be joyful!

The Festival of Lights on the 1 st night “ <i>I Am the light of the world</i> ”	John 8:12
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The Four Species Leviticus 23:40

Citron (<i>etrog</i>) - Sweet tasting & sweet smelling (Knowledge & Deeds)
Date Palm (<i>lulav</i>) - Sweet taste, no smell
Myrtle (<i>hadasim</i>) – No taste, sweet smell
Willow (<i>aravot</i>) – No taste, no smell

The Daily *Sukkot* Ceremony – Priests Divided into 3 Groups:

First group: Offer the sacrifices

Second group: Gathered willow branches & Marched back to the temple

Third group: Headed by High Priest

Went to pool of Siloam (“gently flowing waters”)

Drew water into a gold vase & marched back to the temple

“*Out of My belly flow rivers of living water.*”

Feast of Tabernacles in the Book of Revelation

Waving the <i>Lulav</i>	Rev 7:9
The End Time Harvest	Rev 14:15,18 & 19
The Millennial Kingdom	Rev 21:3

Shm'neh Atzeret (The 8th Day) Linger to be alone with God

Simcha Torah (The Joy of Torah)

Closing of Torah Cycle & beginning of the new Cycle

Yeshua's 2nd Coming will Correspond with Fall Feasts– Repentance for National Israel!
