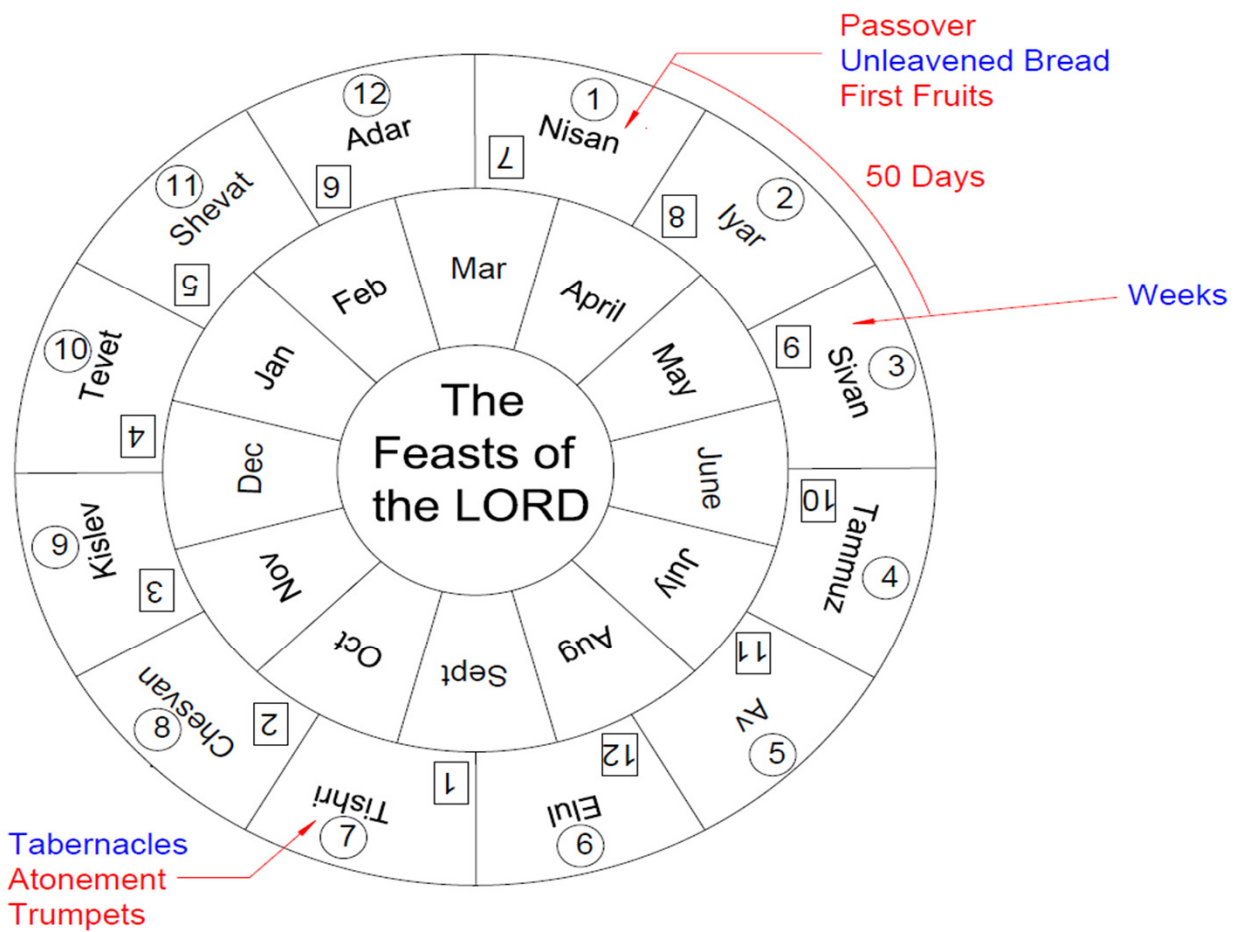

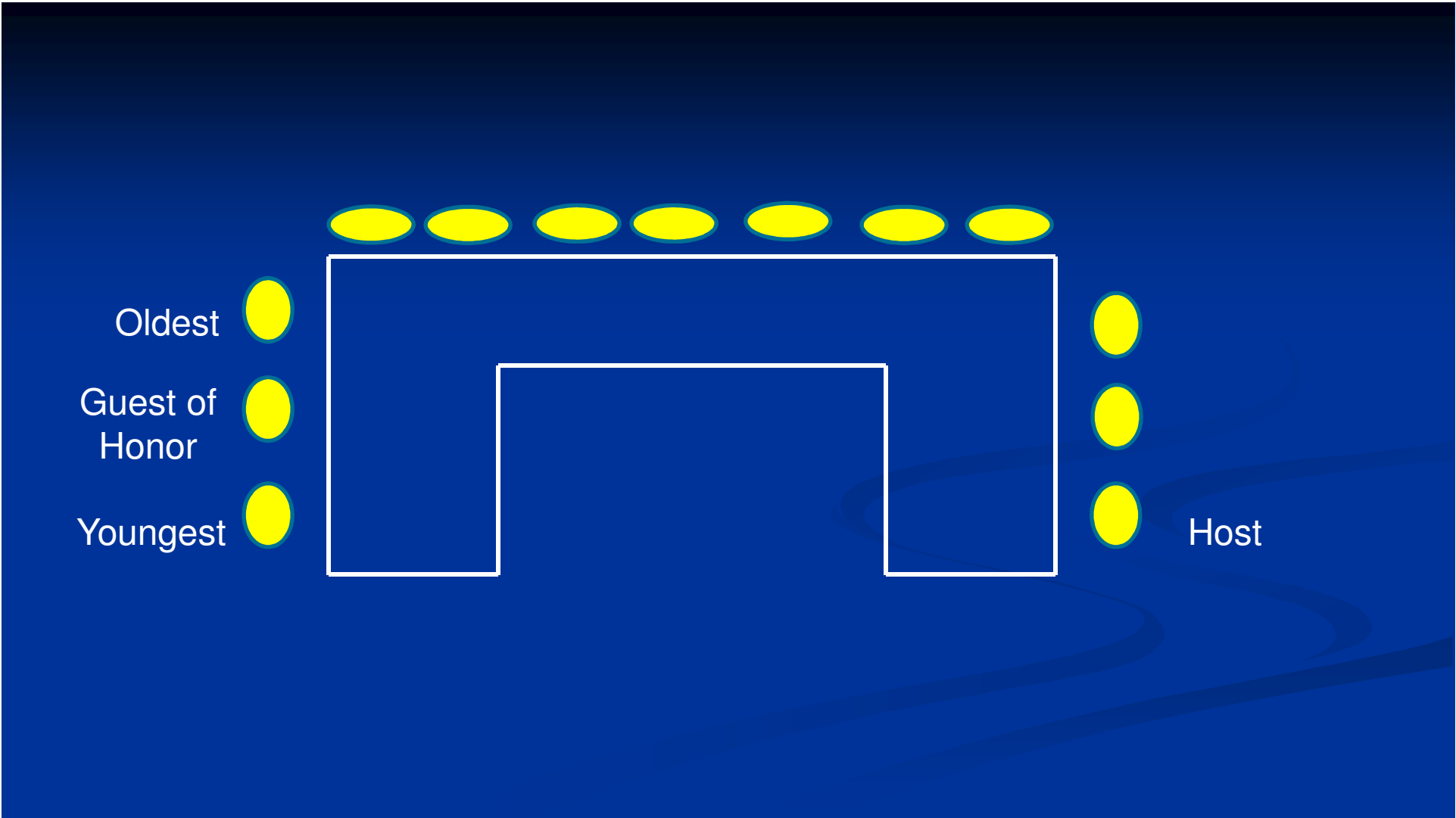

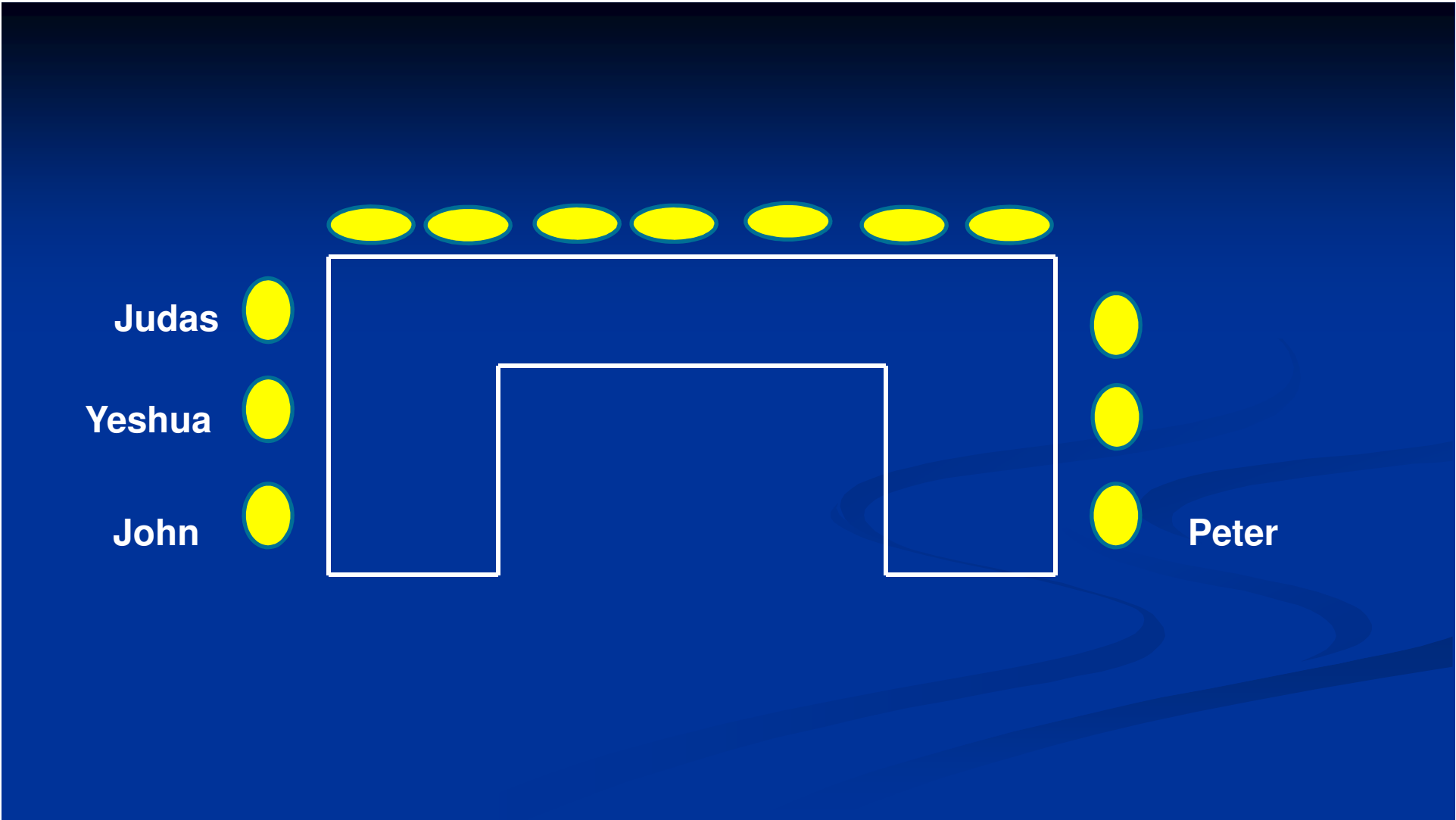

Exodus from Egypt

No Time for Dough to Rise

Ate Bread Unleavened

Tradition:

Removing Leaven from our Houses

Removing Sin from our Lives

“In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at evening, you shall eat unleavened bread, until the twenty-first day of the month at evening. For seven days no leaven shall be found in your houses...you shall eat nothing leavened; in all your dwellings you shall eat unleavened bread.”

Exodus 12:18-19

“And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the Feast of Unleavened Bread to the Lord; seven days you must eat unleavened bread. On the first day you shall have a holy convocation; you shall do no customary work on it. But you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord for seven days. The seventh day shall be a holy convocation; you shall do no customary work on it.”
