Midrash *Korach* ("Korah") Numbers 16:1 – 18:32

"Murmuring" on the way to Sinai & to Kadesh Barnea has led to: Private Confrontation from Aaron & Miriam (two weeks ago) Public Confrontation from Korah & Sons of Reuben (this week's Portion)

Korah's Rebellion Numbers 16:1:11

Korah קבׁת ("Bald") From Levi:

See Deuteronomy 14:1

From Reuben: Dathan ("Belonging to a Fountain") Abiram ("My Father is Exalted")

On ("Wealth" or "Vigor")

Tradition says that *On's* wife talked him out of participating!

Underlying Reasons: Firstborn: Korah & followers are all firstborn in their (Levite) families

Reuben was firstborn of Jacob (Leah)

Jealousy – both thought they should have that birthright

Also: position in the camp contributed to the rebellion

"And they rose up before Moses..." בנים panim "in the face of"

Same word used of Nimrod (not the best company to keep!)

Genesis10:9

Both spoke "for the good of the people" against God's "oppressive rule"

"...famous (men) in the congregation..." \[\bar{\mu} = \bar{\mu} = \bar{\mu} \bar{\mu} \bar{\mu} \] anshay - sham

verse 2

Similar phrase used of the Nephilim

Both lead "their people" to rebel against God

Genesis 6:4

Korah's Complaint: "You take too much upon you, seeing all the congregation is holy."

Is all of the congregation holy at this point in time???

Exodus 19:5-6

"The LORD will show who are His, and who is holy..."

(Aaron the High Priest) (Levites)

This test is to be through the Incense Service

Better be careful ... that didn't work out well for Nadab & Avihu!

Leviticus 10

verse 5

Moses turns their "battle cry" back onto them!

...and chastises them for attacking Aaron – he didn't "appoint himself"

verse 7 verse 11

Korah wanted Moses' assignment from God, not the one that God gave him

.... Yeshua addressed this with His Disciples

John 21:18-23

Numbers 16:12-15

Dathan & Abiram's Rebellion

Moses dealt with Korah first, now it's time for Dathan & Abiram

They acknowledged that would "not come up" --- into the Land

Prophetic that they would descend --- now!

D & A's Complaint: Moses is "misleading" the people to gain power for himself

Brought them into Wilderness to kill them....

Ironically, it's their unbelief that kills them!

The Rebellion is Put Down

Numbers 16:16-35

Korah convinces a large numbers of rebels to join him A picture of "tares sown among the wheat"

Matt 13:24-43

A "Showdown of Censers"

Moses intercedes for the rest of the people; just like

David interceded when he sinned II Sam 24:17 Abraham interceded for Sodom Genesis 18:25 Moses intercede for the Golden Calf Exodus 32:31-32 God doesn't want the righteous to perish with the wicked

Luke 21:20-22

So .. the earth swallowed Korah, Dathan & Abiram alive

....but not all of Korah's family – the Sons of Korah survived to write Psalms 44-49

Num 26:11

Korah & the Reubenites - Tares among the Wheat!

The Consequences of Rebellion (Starts Chapter 17 in Jewish Bible)

Numbers 16:36-50

Matthew 13: 24-30

Tribal assignments: Levi was scattered among the 12 Tribes & Reuben placed east of the Jordan

The 250 thought they were offering incense ... but they became the Burnt Offering!

Their censers were melted and attached to the Altar, for a "sign" Only the Priests could approach ... & with humility!

The added weight was a reminder to those who carried it (Korah's relatives)!

The Plague Begins: 14,700 + Korah, Dathan & Abiram (& families) + 250 princes

The Incense Offering was vital in the Atonement ritual

Leviticus 16:12-13

Up to now, the people associated it with death

...but here Aaron uses it to stay the plague and bring life!

Aaron stood between life and death!

Budding of Aaron's Rod

Numbers 17:1-13

One Prince from each of the 12 Tribes was to present a rod to the LORD

The rod that buds (comes to life) is the one that He chooses

Further confirmation of Aaron's Priesthood

Wood represents humanity; dead wood represents death

Aaron's rod was "resurrected" to yield fruit

A picture of Yeshua

.. our High Priest thru Resurrection (not Levitical Priesthood)

Hebrews 4:14-16 & 7:24-28

Aaron's budded rod was placed inside the ark as a "sign"

....not to murmur against God nor His Chosen Manna was also placed in the Ark

- Both Held in Contempt by the People

As a result, the people feared that anyone who came too close to the Tabernacle would die!

But ... there is the proper way to approach without death!

For us to approach God, we must die to ourselves!

Confirmation of the Priesthood

Numbers 18:1-7

Priests & Levites are responsible for the Sanctuary Levites protect the Outer Court & the People

Aaron & Priests protect the Holy Place & Holy of Holies

... and the Levites

Tithes & Offerings

God gets the best!

Numbers 18:8-32

Verse 30

Salt Covenant: Preservative – Prevents Decay

Used on Sacrifices

An Everlasting Covenant

II Chronicles 13:5

What did Yeshua mean: "You are the salt of the earth."

Matthew 5:13

No land inheritance, therefore:

The congregation tithed to the Levites
The Levites tithed to the Priests

verse 21 verse 26

Haftarah: I Samuel 11:14-12:22 Samuel Transfers His Authority to Saul

Brit Chadashah: Matthew 26:57-65 Yeshua challenges Caiaphas' authority

Revelation 8:1-7 Repeat of *Korah's* Judgment in the End Times
