This was the turning point for Israel: failure meant 38+ more years!

& Deut 1:22-23

One man from each tribe: Levi excluded

Ephraim & Manasseh included

Their Objectives: See the <u>People</u>: Are they strong or weak?

Are they few or many?

See the Land: Is it good or bad?

Walled cities or tents?

Fat or lean? Wooded or not?

And bring back some fruit

Explored the Negev in the South & all the way to Mt Herman in the North

"of the Tribe of Asher, <u>S'tur</u>...."  $\uparrow$  in  $\uparrow$  in

The Spies' Report Numbers 13:25-33

Searched 40 days; Gave "Bad" Report on 9<sup>th</sup> of *Av* (5<sup>th</sup> month).

Other events occurring on 9<sup>th</sup> of Av in history:

1st Temple destroyed by Nebuchadnezzar in 587 BC

2<sup>nd</sup> Temple destroyed by Titus in 70 AD

Destruction of Bar Kochva's army in 135 AD

1<sup>st</sup> Crusade (Pope Urban II) started in 1095

England expelled all Jews in 1290

Spain expelled all Jews in 1492 (Columbus)

World War I started in 1914

Hitler's "Final Solution" started in 1942

Gaza turned over to Palestinians on the eve of the 9th of Av in 1994

2 with Good report: Joshua (Ephraim) & Caleb (Judah)

The sin of the 10 was not just unbelief, but they also convinced others!

Israel's Rejection of God Numbers 14:1-38 God's reaction to Israel's rejection is very severe – just like at Golden Calf verses 11-12 Moses intercedes for the people – just like at the Golden Calf verses 13-19 (Connection to the Egyptian Plagues) The sentence: Death to 1st generation over the next 38 years verse 29 The 10 "Bad-Reporters" struck dead on the spot! verse 37 Numbers 14:22 Israel tested God 10 times: 1. Exodus 14:11-12 Before the Red Sea At Bitter Waters of Marah 2. Exodus 15:22-24 3. Exodus 16:1-3 Ran out of food in the Wilderness of Sin 4. Exodus 16:20 Left the manna until morning Tried gathering manna on Shabbat 5. Exodus 16:27-8 6. Exodus 17:1-3 Had no water at Rephadim 7. Exodus 32 Worshipped the Golden Calf 8. Numbers 11:1 Rebelled against God's commandments at Sinai 9. Numbers 11:4 Lusted for meat Believed the spies' report at Kadesh-Barnea 10. Numbers 14:1-4 Numbers 14:39-45 Second Thoughts Israel launched an incursion into Canaan but is driven out God was not with them! The rest of the Exodus is "marching in place" while this first generation dies off. The Offerings Numbers 15:1-21 Gives instructions for the accompanying meal & drink offerings Did Israel offer sacrifices during Exodus?...and did God accept them? Amos 5:18-27 Offerings for Unintentional Sins Numbers 15:22-31 When the entire congregation sinned...perhaps "led astray" by the Priests... Then Aaron made atonement for the entire congregation Stoning the Shabbat-Breaker Numbers 15:32-36 Death penalty for breaking ANY of God's Commandments Not the same situation as Yeshua & Pharisees They added to God's Law The Fringes of Remembrance Numbers 15:37-41 "Fringes" tzi-tzit We are to Look, Remember & Do James 1:23-24 ...so we do not follow our eyes & hearts ...our 10 "bad spies"!

The *tzi-tzit* is a symbol of authority: Saul & David I Samuel 24:1-8

Yeshua & Pharisees Matthew 23:5

Woman with Issue of Blood Matt 9:18-26 & Mark 5:25-34

What the Rabbis say: Numerical value of the word *tzi-tzit* is 600

One *tzi-tizt* consists of: 8 Cords + 5 Knots

... for a total of 613 Commandments in Torah

365 "Negative" Commandments ("Thou Shalt Not") (One for each day of the year)

248 "Positive" Commandments ("Thou Shalt") (Number of days remaining after all the Shabbats & Holy Days are subtracted.)

This Portion starts and ends with the concept of "seeing" and "perceiving".

*Haftarah*: Joshua 2:1-24 The 2<sup>nd</sup> Set of Spies into the Promised Land

Brit Chadashah: Revelation 11:1-3 God's End-Time Judgment on Israel
