

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Tithe went to the sanctuary to be eaten there In the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> years "Year of Tithing": In the 3rd & 6th years it stayed home & went to the poor
