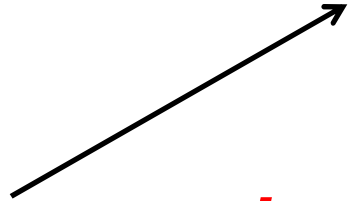

What Do We Do on the **Feast of Trumpets?**

Minimum: Know When it is (Evening of Sept 6)

Scriptural: Do No Regular Work
 Come Together with Believers
 Hear the Sound of the Shofar
 Bring an Offering to Yehovah

What Do We Do on the **Day of Atonement**?

Minimum: Know When it is (Evening of Sept 15)

Scriptural:

- Do No Work**
- Come Together With Believers**
- Afflict Your Soul**
- Bring an Offering to Yehovah**

The Feast of Tabernacles:

15th – 22nd Day of the 7th Month

Holy Convocation

Do No Work (1st and 8th Days)

Rejoice! (Our Harvest Work is Finished!)

Dwell in Booths (Remember Exodus)

Bring Many Offerings to Yehovah

The Feast of Tabernacles Traditions:

All Priests Served (Pilgrimage Feast)

1st Group: Offered Sacrifices

2nd Group: Willow Ceremony

3rd Group: Water Libation Ceremony

“...Fountains of Living Water”

First Night: Festival of Lights

“I am the Light of the World.”

Feast of Tabernacles Past, Present & Future:

1st: Tabernacle Construction Started

Today: Thanksgiving Holiday

Future: Yeshua's Millennial Kingdom
