## **The First Feast**

***“Six days shall work be done, but the seventh day is a Sabbath of solemn rest, a holy convocation. You shall do no work on it; it is the Sabbath of the Lord in all your dwellings.”***

**Leviticus 23:3**

***Blessed is the man who does this, and the son of man who lays hold on it; who keeps from defiling the Sabbath, and keeps his hand from doing any evil. Do not let the son of the foreigner who has joined himself to the Lord speak, saying, “The Lord has utterly separated me from His people”; nor let the eunuch say, “Here I am, a dry tree.”***

**Minimum:** Know When it is (Evening of Sept 6)

**Scriptural:** Do No Regular Work  
Come Together with Believers  
Hear the Sound of the Shofar  
Bring an Offering to Yehovah

**Rabbinic:** Jewish Traditions

**10<sup>th</sup> Day of the 7<sup>th</sup> Month**

**Holy Convocation**

**Do No Work**

**Afflict Your Soul (Fasting??)**

**Bring an Offering to Yehovah**

# What Do We Do on the Day of Atonement?

**Minimum:** Know When it is (Evening of Sept 15)

**Scriptural:**

- Do No Work
- Come Together With Believers
- Afflict Your Soul
- Bring an Offering to Yehovah

**Rabbinic:** Jewish Traditions
