



Chapter 12 A New Calendar Passover Unleavened Bread

Passover Sequence of Events Exodus 12 Lamb Selected on the 10<sup>th</sup> of Nisan Lamb Inspected for 4 Days Lamb Killed on the 14<sup>th</sup> of Nisan **Blood Applied to Doorposts & Lintel** Lamb Roasted with Fire Eaten with Unleavened Bread & Bitter Herbs Stay in House Until Destroyer has Passed

#### **Mechanics of the Death of the Firstborn**

#### **2-Step Process:**

"For the Lord will pass through to strike the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, (1) the Lord will pass over the door and (2) not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike you." [pass by] Exodus 12:23







"Seven days you shall eat unleavened bread, and on the seventh day there shall be a feast to the Lord. Unleavened bread shall be eaten seven days. ...'This is done because of what the Lord did for me when I came up from Egypt.' It shall be as a sign to you on your hand and as a memorial between your eyes, that the Lord's law may be in your mouth; for with a strong hand the Lord has brought you out of Egypt. You shall therefore keep this ordinance in its season from year to year." Exodus 13:6-10
