Stay in House Until Destroyer has Passed

Mechanics of the Death of the Firstborn

2-Step Process:

“For the Lord will pass through to strike the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, (1) the Lord will pass over the door and (2) not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike you.” [pass by]

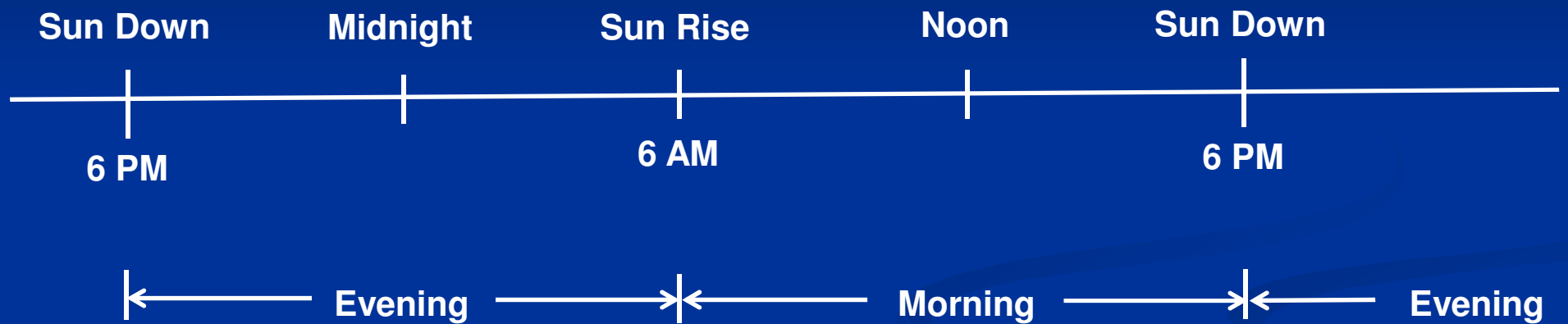

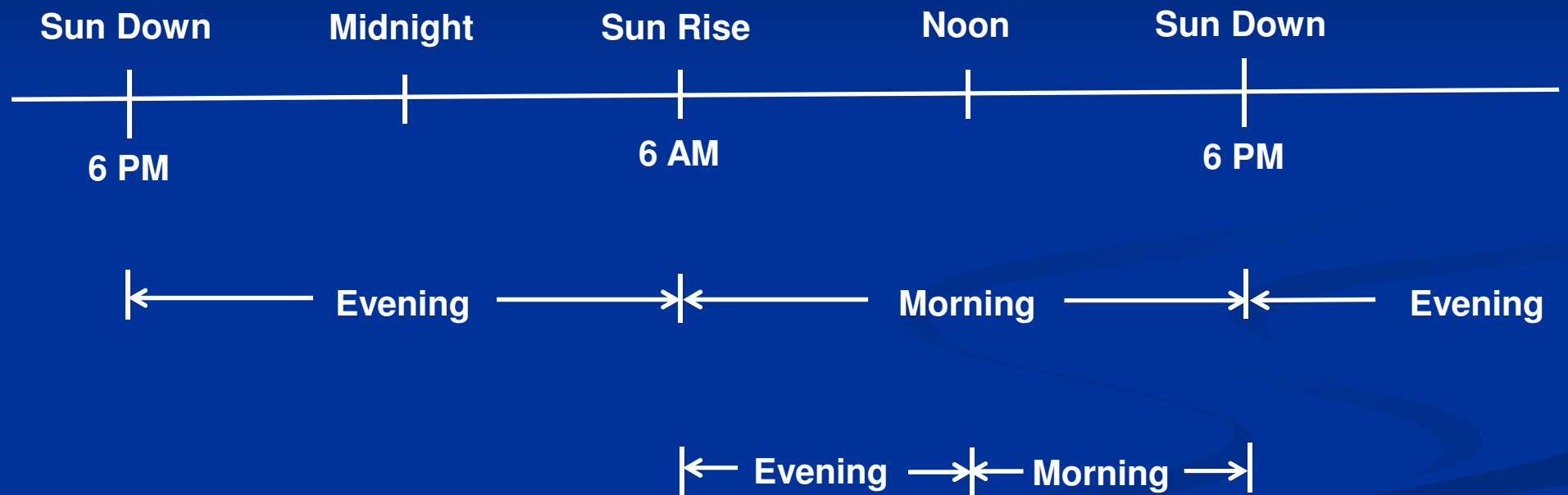

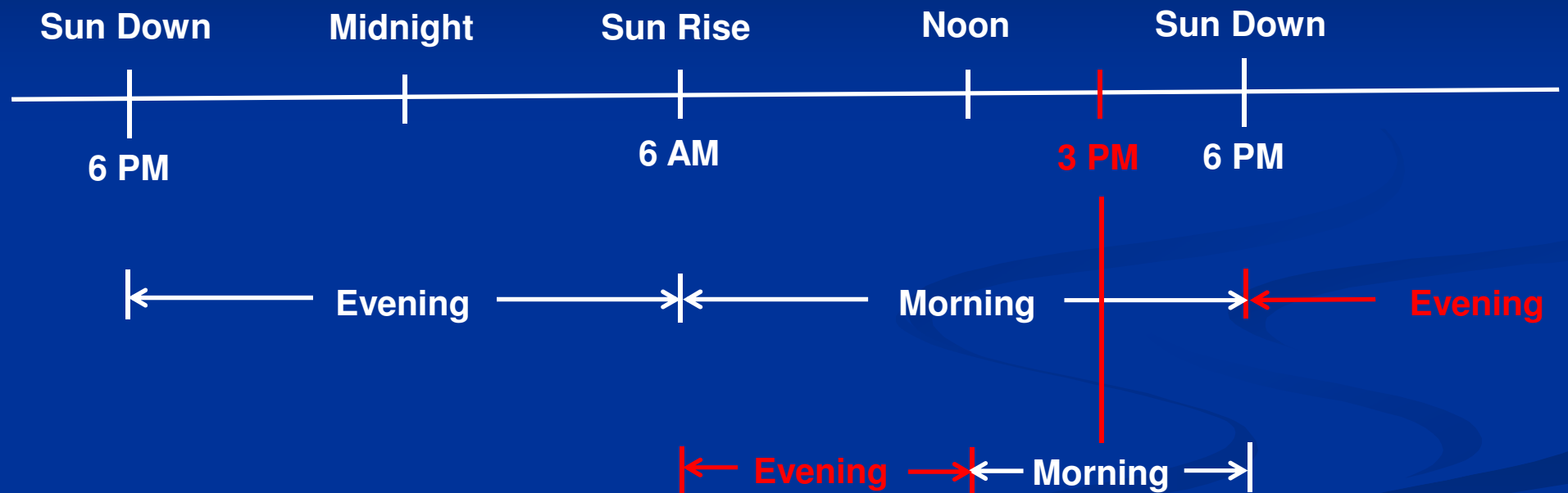

“Seven days you shall eat unleavened bread, and on the seventh day there shall be a feast to the Lord.
