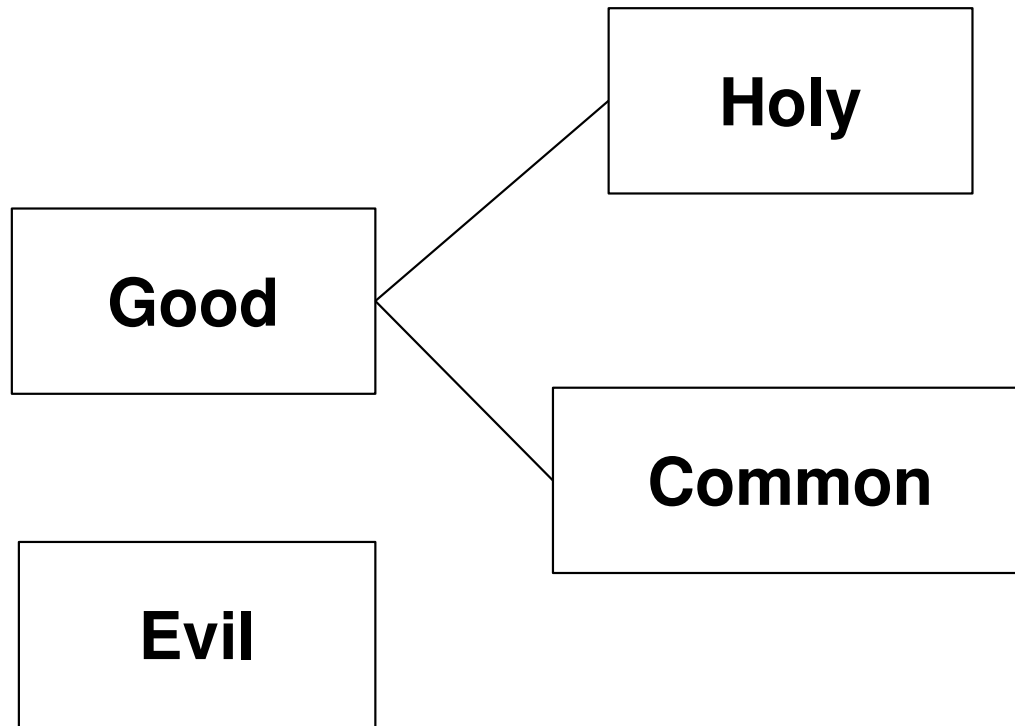

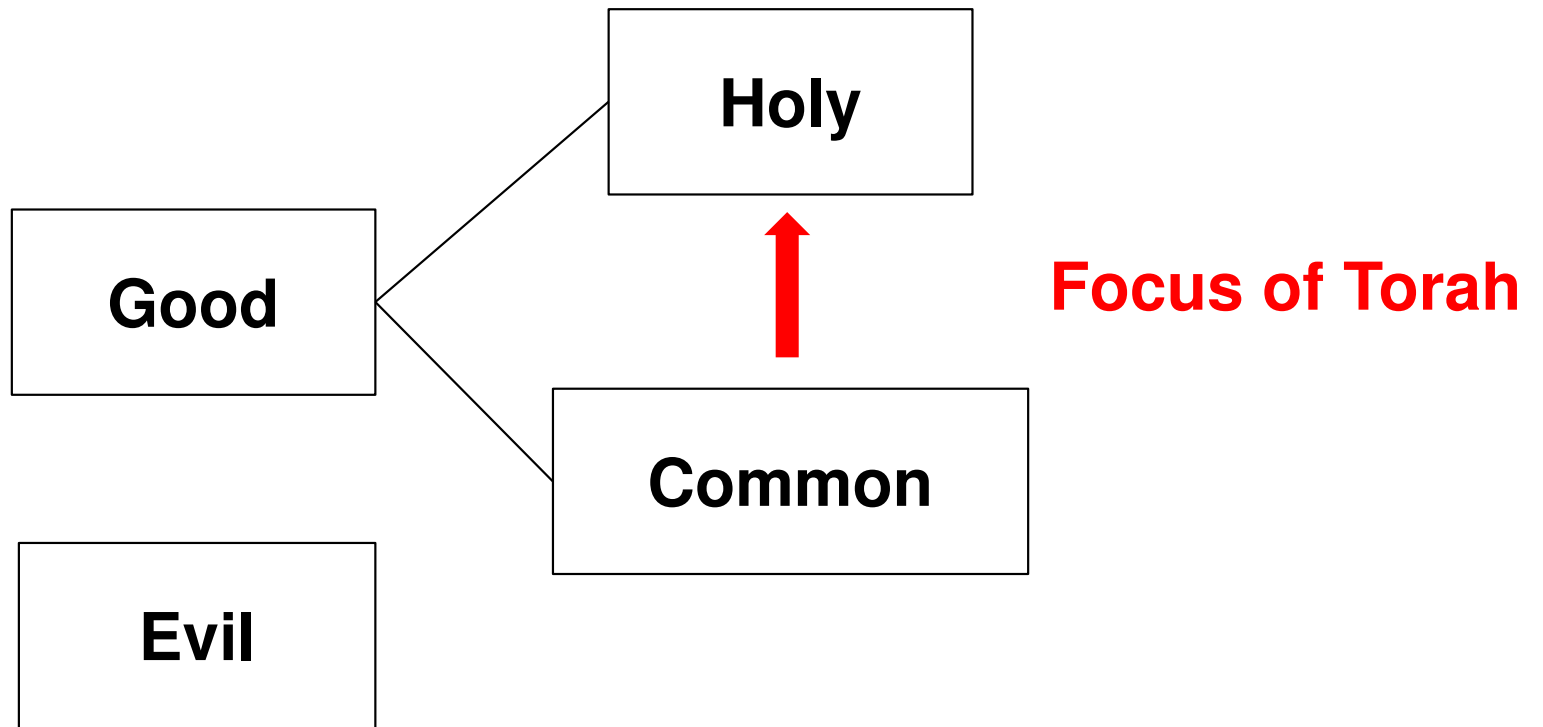

## **The Law of Trees:**
