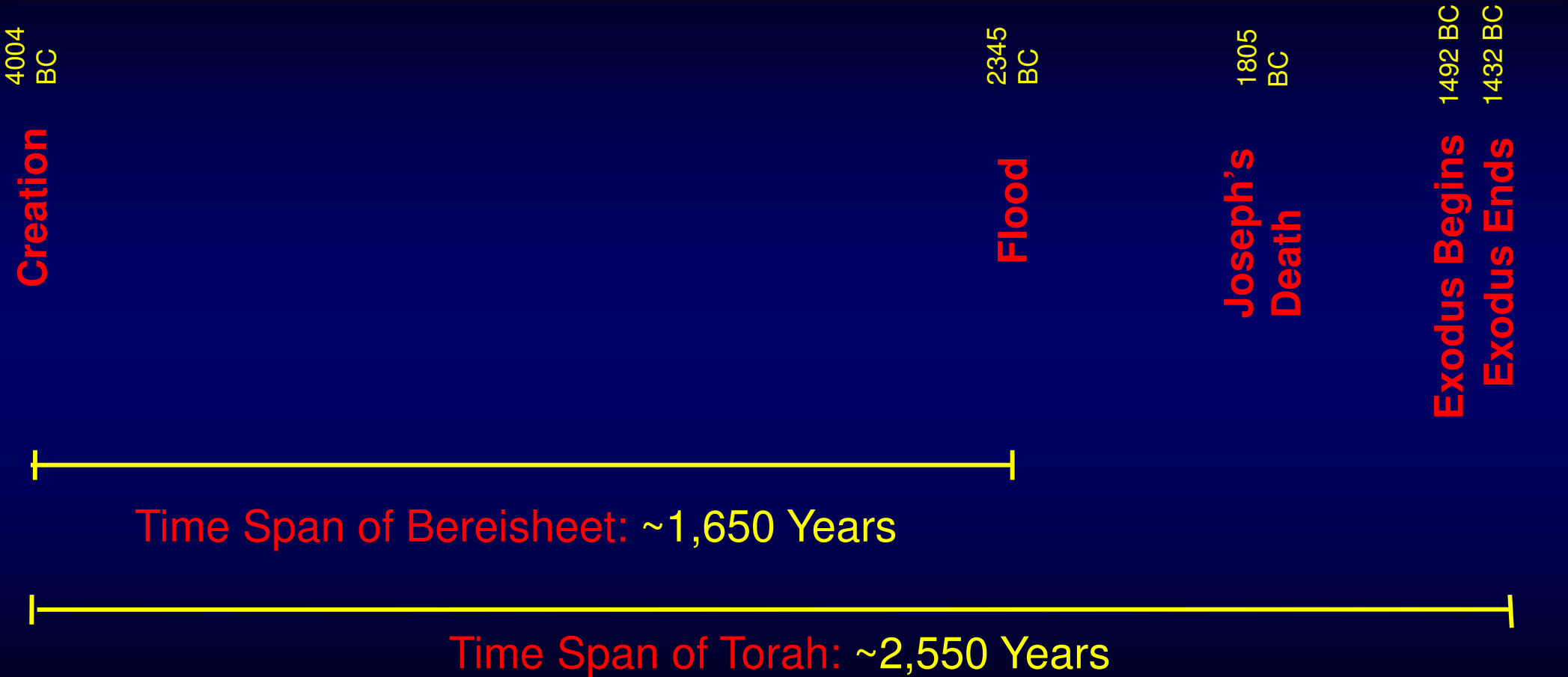

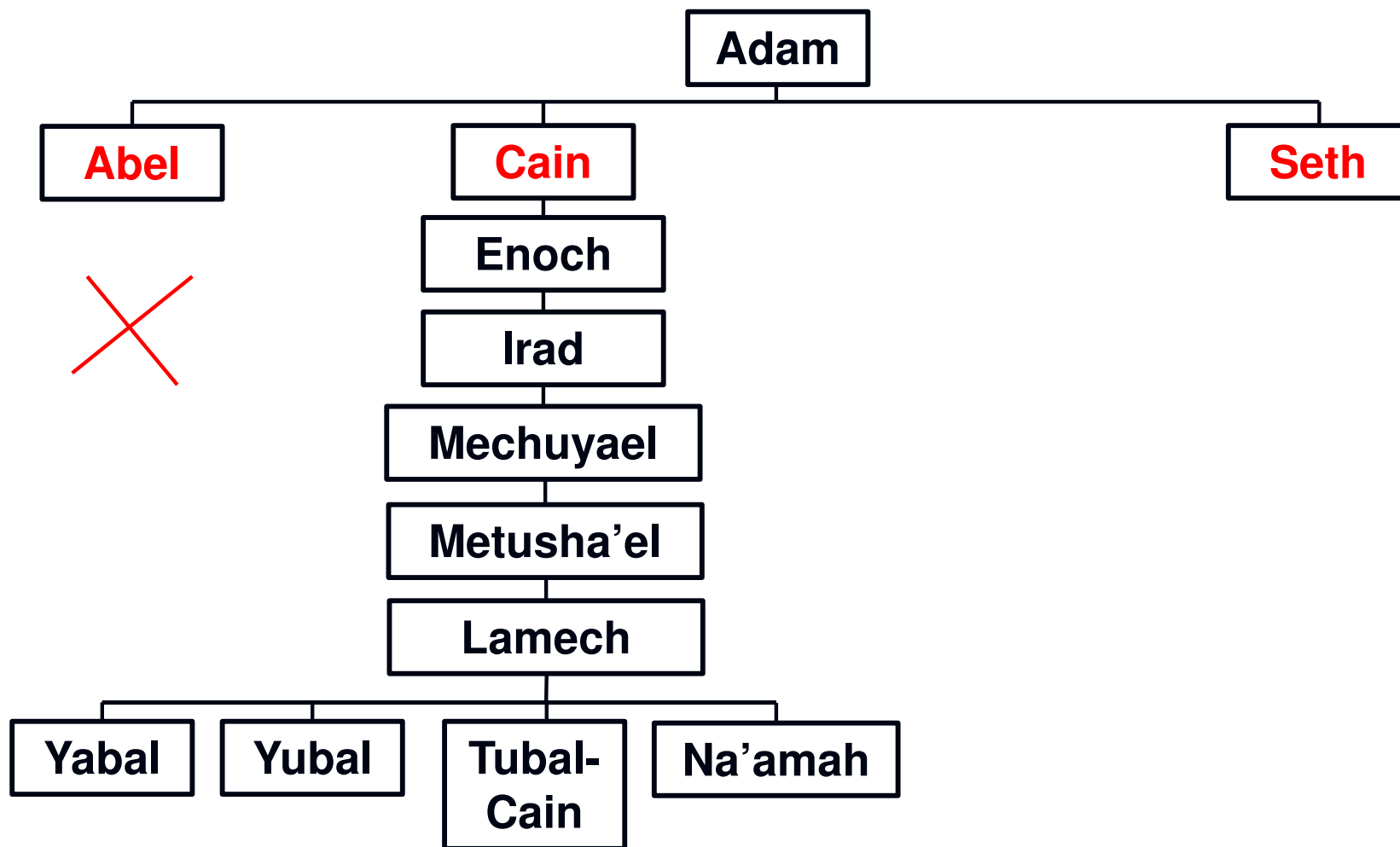
Cain & Abel

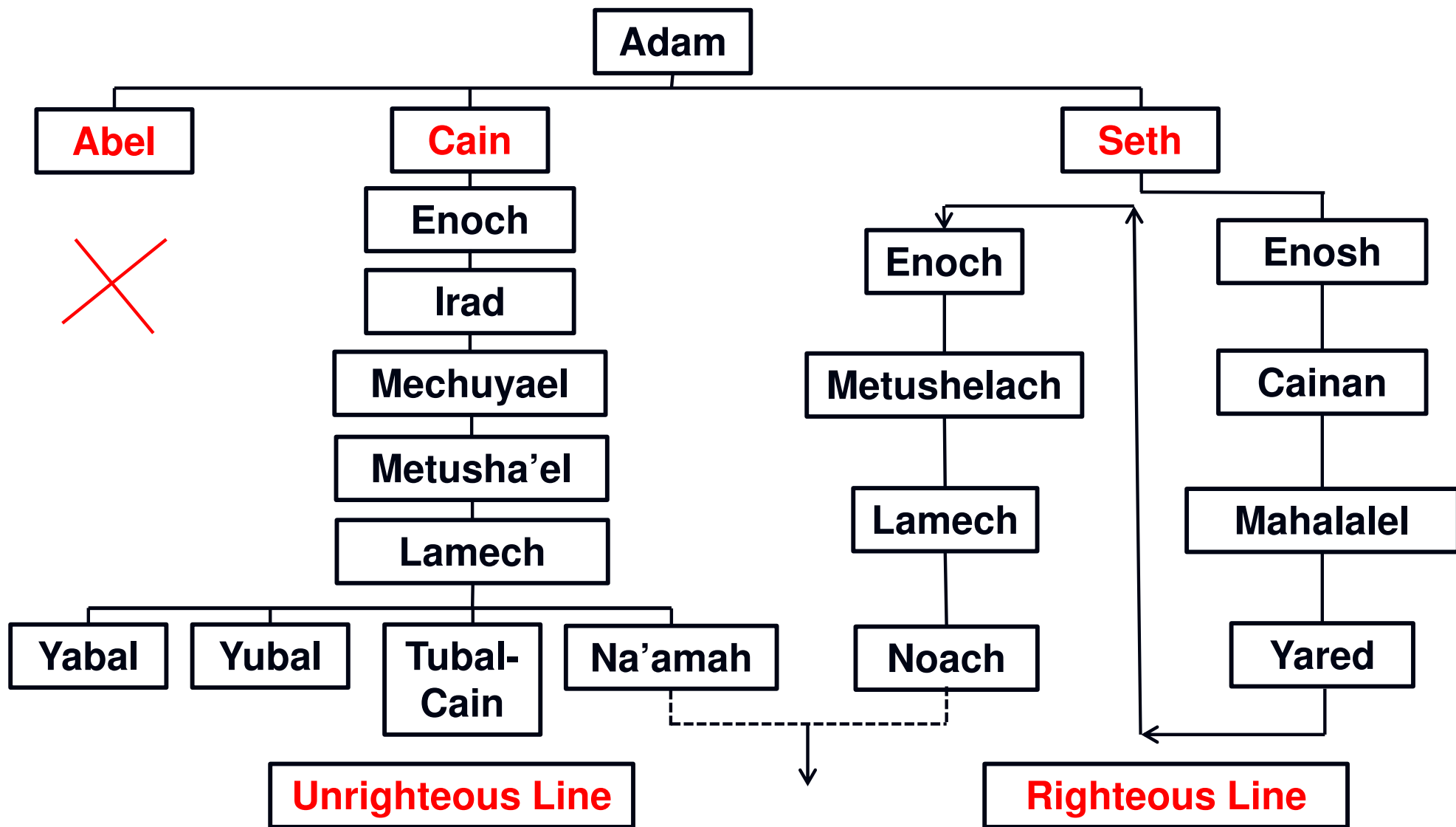

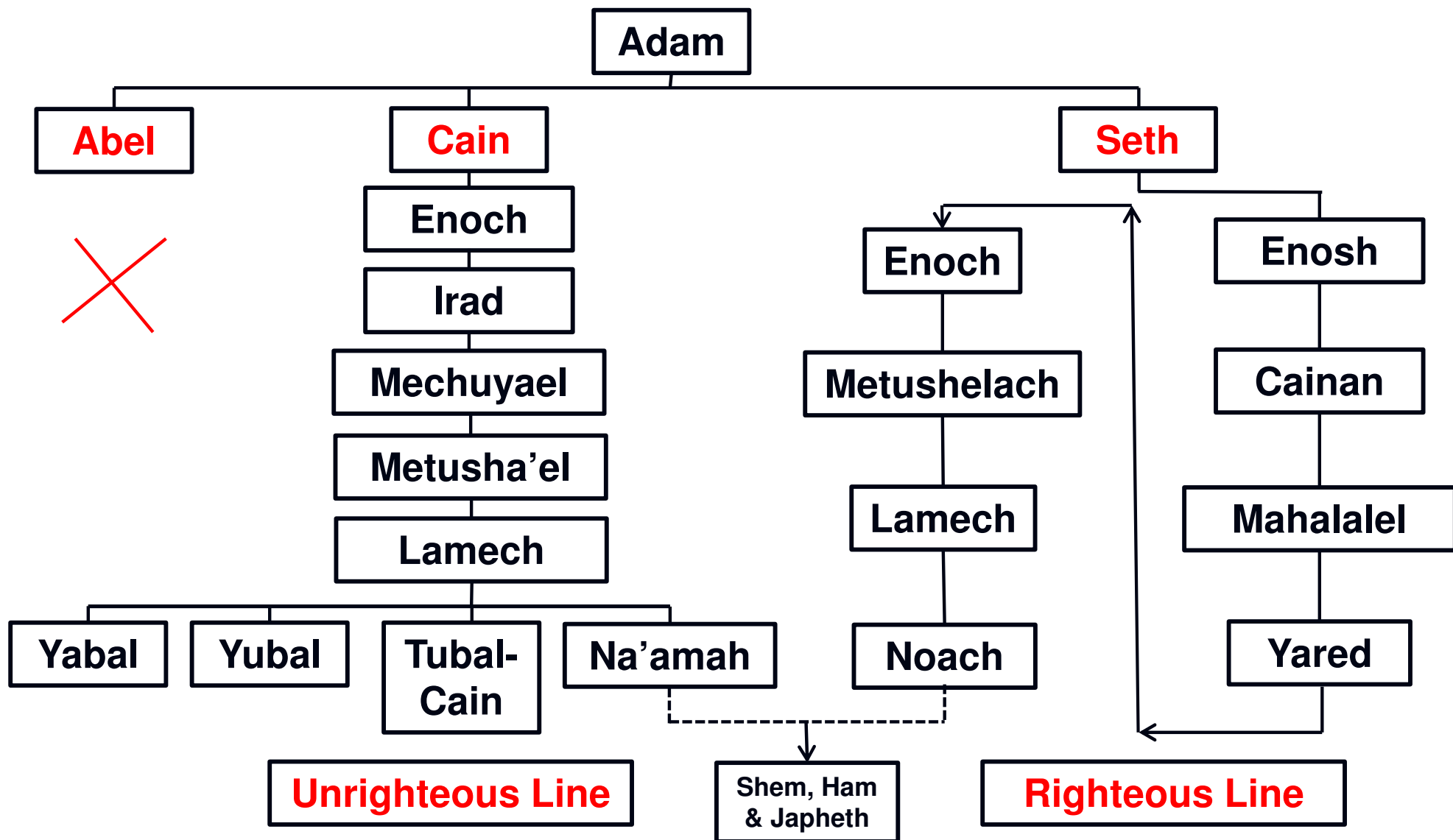

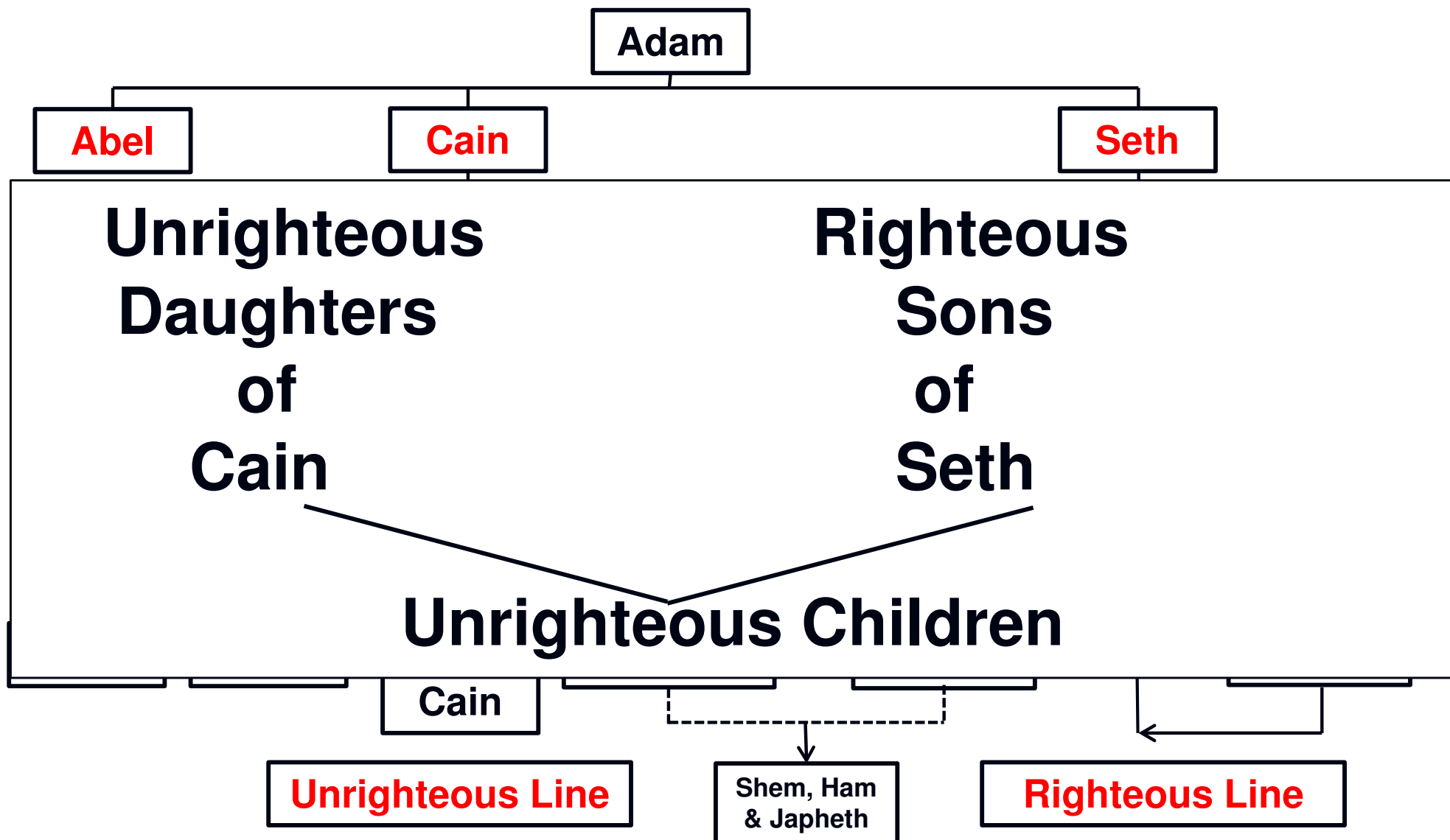
