Levi (in Abram's loins) is subservient to *Melchizedek* Hebrews 7:9-10

Pre-dates Book of the Law Separation of Priests (Levi) from Kings (Judah)

Offered Bread & Wine

No Record of Birth or Death

Hebrews 7:3

"Melchizedek" is the title of an office....

...not to be confused with the humans that held that office throughout history

In the Millennium:

The Order of *Melchizedek* supersedes the Levitical Priesthood
