- 3) Do Not Murder**
- 4) No Incest Adultery, Bestiality or Homosexual Relations**
- 5) Do Not Steal**
- 6) Do Not Eat Live Animals**
- 7) Establish a Legal System to Insure Obedience to the Law**

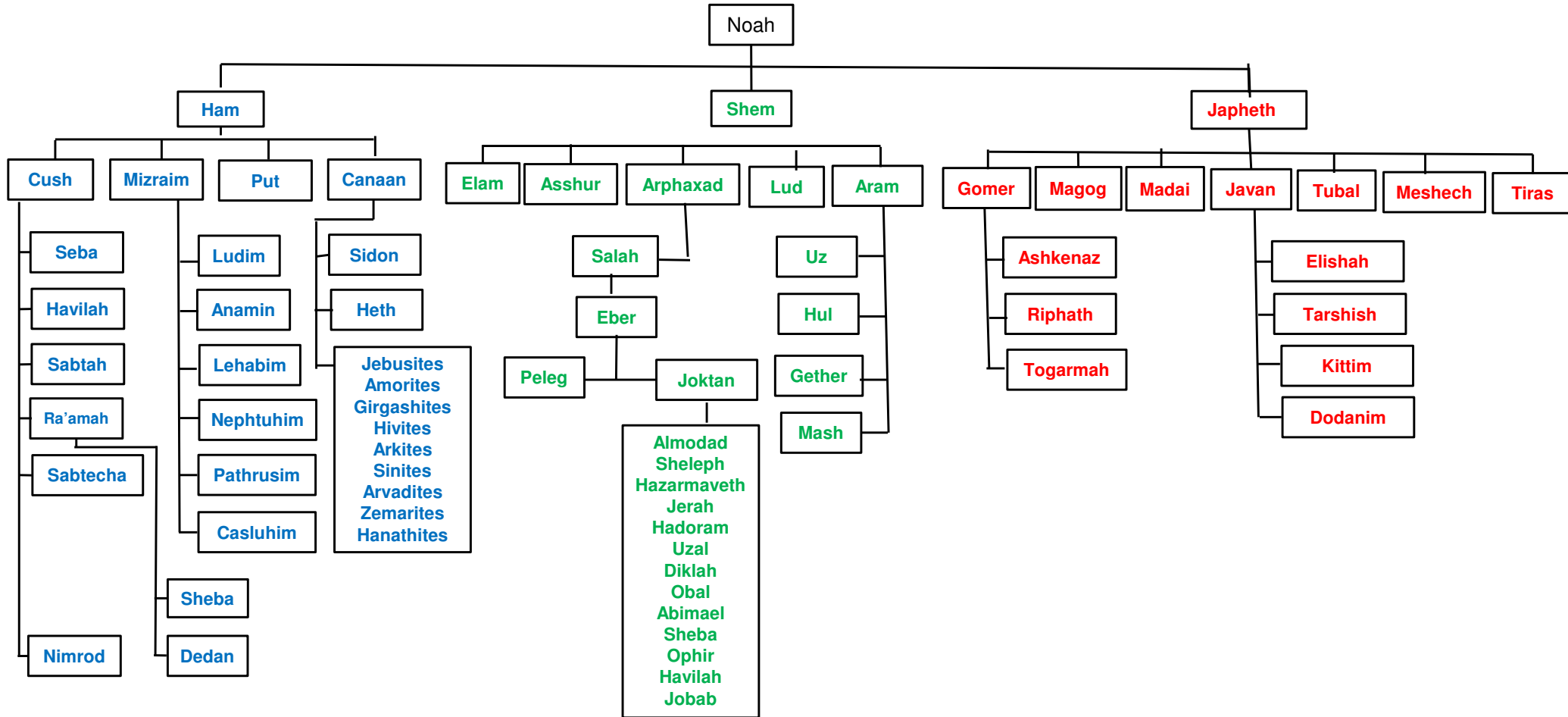

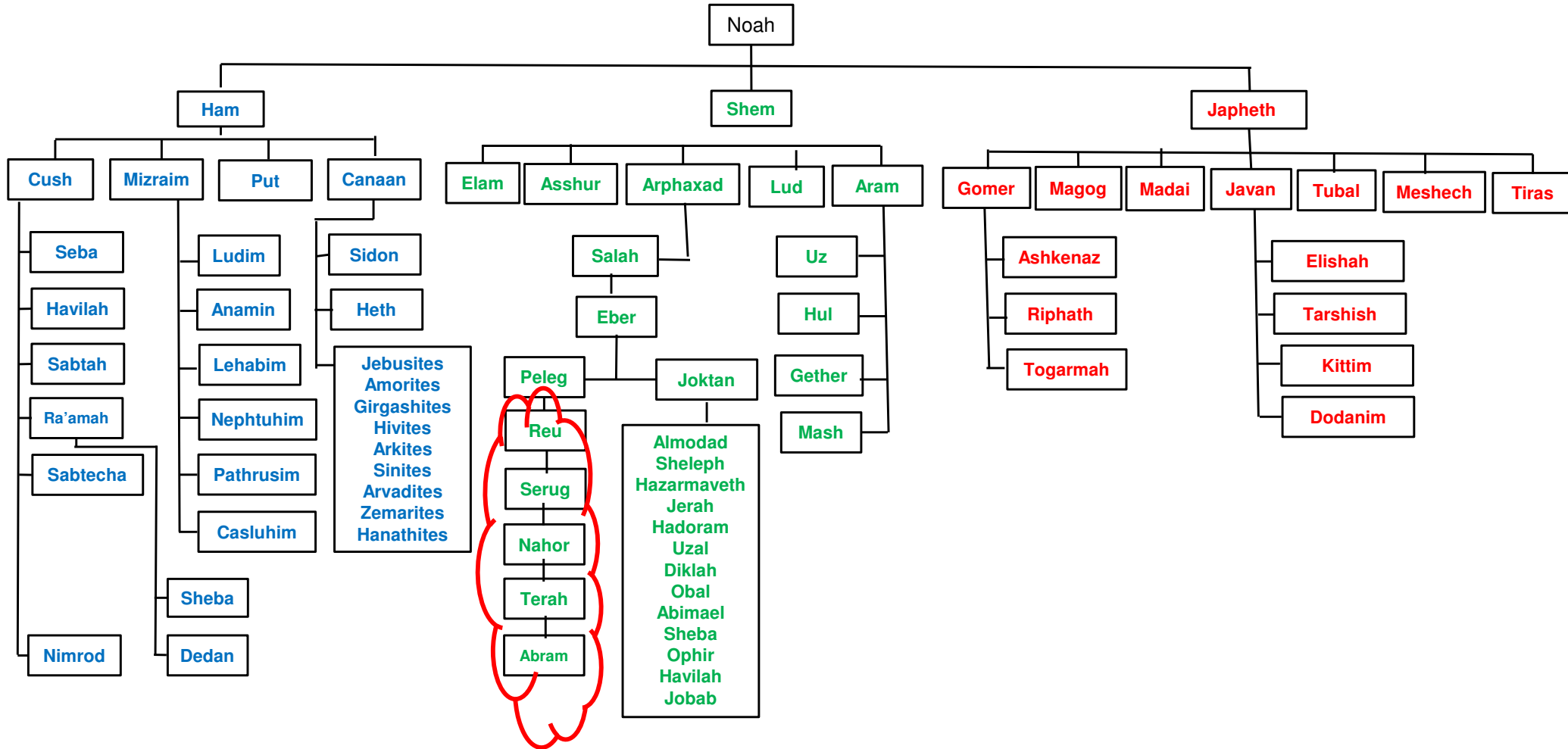

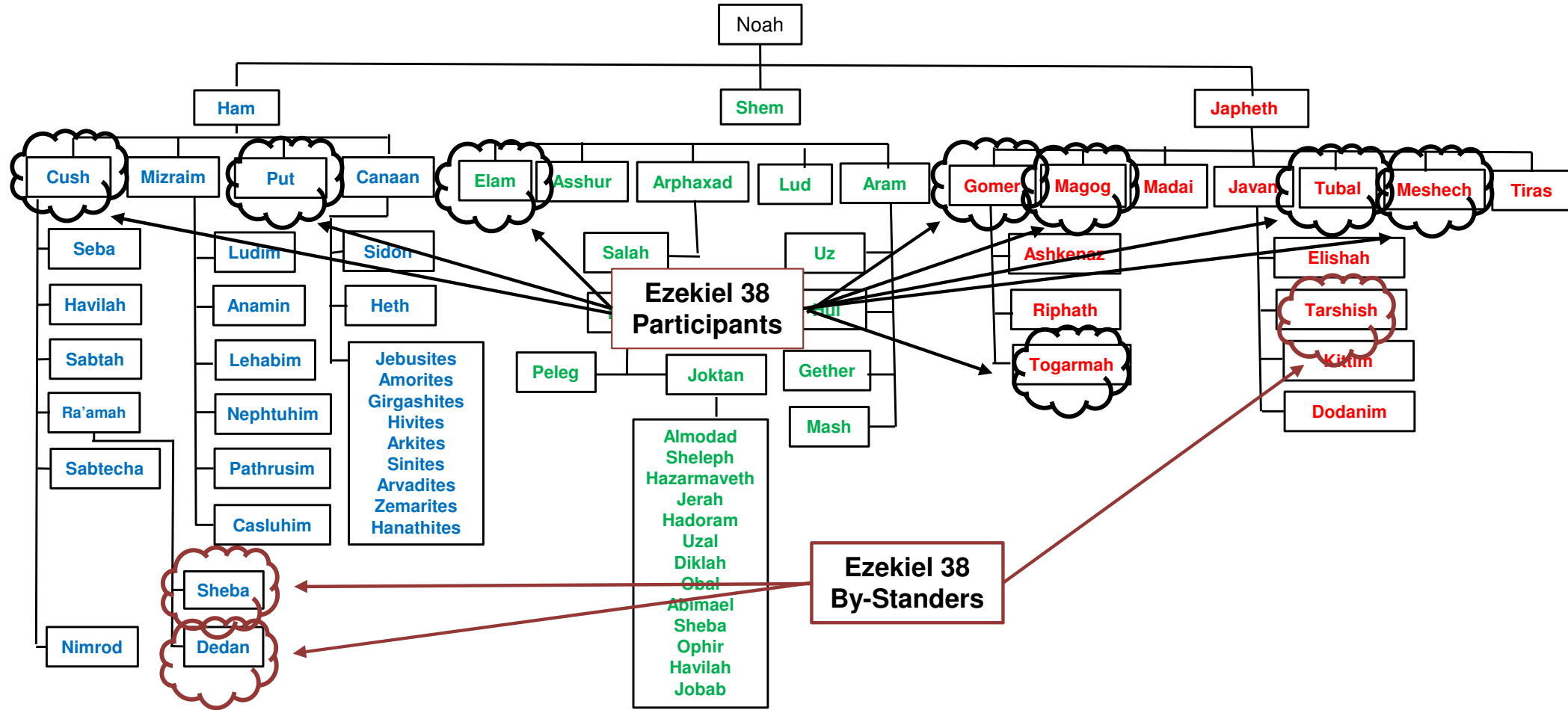
