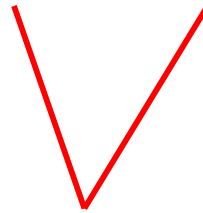

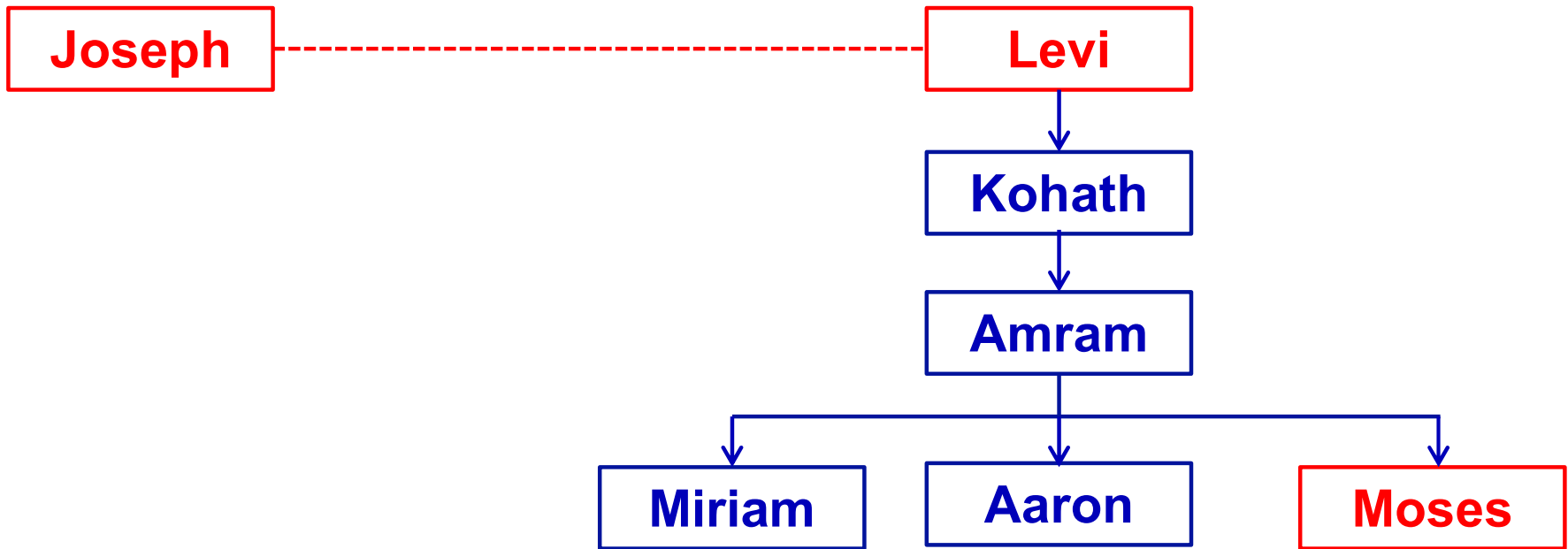

## **Some Additional Details from Book of *Jasher***

**Killed the Egyptian & Fled at Age 18 (Chap 71)**

**Went to Cush; Led Rebellion for 9 Years**

**Reigned as King of Cush for 40 years (72 & 73)**

**At Age 66 Traveled to Midian (Chap 76)**

**Lived in Midian for 14 Years Before Returning  
to Egypt at Age 80**

## **Moses in Midian:**

**Moses Met *Zipporah* by a Well**

***Zipporah* = “Little Bird”**

**She Thought He was Egyptian (like Joseph)**

**Firstborn Son = *Gershom***

***ger* - “Stranger” + *sham* – “There”**

**Second Born Son = *Eliezer***
